Bit of VA, and a proud flare of sun-sweetened plums and berries. Doesn't taste particularly of Cabernet Sauvignon. Ripe, almost strawberry sweet, redcurrants perhaps, toffee overlay, autumn leaves, beetroot earthiness. Cigar-box spice. Composed but open and generous, plums cooked in sweet sherry with walnuts. Gentle. (TC)
